

TERMS OF USE

Last updated: March 1, 2026

1. Acceptance of these Terms

These Terms of Use (“Terms”) govern your access to and use of this website and any related mobile sites, applications, patient support portals, or online services that link to these Terms (collectively, the “Site”). By accessing or using the Site, you agree to be bound by these Terms and our Privacy Policy. If you do not agree, do not use the Site.

The Site is intended for residents of the United States who are at least 18 years old and, where required, for parents or legal guardians acting on behalf of minor patients. By using the Site, you represent that you meet these requirements and, if applicable, that you are authorized to act on behalf of the patient.
